




Matthew 2:13-15: The flight to Egypt. Painting by Joe Maniscalco.




Luke 2:1-7: Gustave Doré's drawing of the Nativity.




Luke 2:7-16: A stone manger still in place in the archaeological excavations at ancient Megiddo.

Luke 2:8-20: Angels appear to the shepherds in the Bethlehem fields.






Adoration of the Magi by Murillo, 17th century



Angel Gabriel's Annunciation to Mary, by Murillo, c. 1655




