For the first edition of the King James Version in the spring of 1611, while in the fall of 1611 the second edition was published. You can down load the first edition digital scanned images of the whole bible even with the first 76 pages and the apocrypha books. For most supporters the bible admits that there has made changes in spelling as 400 years words have changed. Beyond that there were other changes it is not word for word all the way through the New King James Version. This is a collection of 37 words with all the occurrence of each word in all four versions with different results for the NKJV although the first three have the same results.

A common word like Christ and Jesus; should be used the same numbers for each version, I have inclued the verses differences on the end of this document. There are a lot of other articles on the web about this subject of the changes in the NKJV. Most of the new bible versions do the same Jesus for Joshua substation.
